#### **Introduction:**

The AANP is proud to be the *only* association exclusively focused on the clinical and scientific practice of neuropathology in the United States. During the first full week of every June, AANP provides cutting-edge educational sessions led by the nation's preeminent neuropathologists at their Annual Meeting.

The meeting includes a one-day Special Course, which features two “What Every Neuropathologist Needs to Know” sessions, two days of scientific sessions (platform and poster), an evening Diagnostic Slide Session, and a half-day Presidential Symposium.

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#### **93<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting Summary:**

- The 93<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting of the AANP was held from June 8 – 11, 2017 at the Hyatt Regency in Orange County, California.
- Nearly 400 participants were in attendance.

- Thursday, June 8 featured the *Special Course: Genetics, Genomics, and Epigenomics in Clinical Neuropathology Practice and Understanding Autism*, as well as updates on the WHO classification and molecular analyses of CNS tumors.
- Friday June 9 and Saturday June 10 featured Platform sessions, named lectures and poster viewing
- Saturday night, June 10 featured the annual Diagnostic Slide Session
- The meeting concluded on Sunday, June 11 with the *Presidential Symposium*.
- The AANP honored recipients of the 2017 awards for Meritorious Contributions to Neuropathology to Harry V. Vinters, MD, UCLA and Ronald C. Kim, MD, University of California, Irvine.
