### **Annual Meeting:**

**The 131st Meeting of the Association of Clinical Scientists will be held in Louisville, Kentucky and hosted by the University of Louisville School of Medicine, from Wednesday, 18 May, to Sunday, 22 May 2011.** The scientific program will highlight the area of Genomics and Personalized Medicine, and will also feature platform sessions of keynote lectures and research papers devoted to Cell and Tissue Pathology, Clinical Biochemistry and Biotechnology, Clinical Molecular Biology and Genetics, Oncology and Proteomics, Clinical Immunology and Microbiology, Hematology and Transfusion Medicine, Therapeutics and Toxicology, Clinical Informatics and Computer Systems, and Clinical Science in Practice. A Surgical Pathology Tutorial on Interstitial Lung Diseases will be given by Mostafa Fraig, and a tour of the laboratories at the University of Louisville Hospital is planned. The meeting headquarters will be the historic Seelbach Hilton Hotel, located in downtown Louisville. As in previous years, the meeting will also include an art show and musicale, and a Run-for-the Lilies.

Highlighted events include the Claude P. Brown Memorial Lecture, "Deciphering the Genomics of Cancer to Predict Clinical Behavior," presented by James L. Wittliff MD PhD, University of Louisville, Louisville, KY, and the Award presentations at the Association's Annual Reception and Banquet:
