### ACVP 2015 Annual Report to Intersociety Pathology Council (IPC)

**2012-2017 Strategic Plan** – Implementation continues. Relevant to this plan, ACVP implemented the following:

- Certifying Examination Phase I and Phase II – Beginning in 2015, Phase I will be given electronically at testing sites, and Phase II will (continue to) be given in Ames, IA. Both phases will be equated with the passing points established in 2014.
- ACVP website redesign began at the end of 2014. The new design is expected to be introduced in the Spring of 2015. It will include the portal for Maintenance of Certification, which will begin in 2016.
- ACVP continues to foster international relationships and will discuss a strategy to give the International Veterinary Pathology Coalition, formed in 2013, more independence.

#### Certifications

In 2014, ACVP Certified 56 new veterinary anatomic pathologists, 24 new veterinary clinical pathologists, and one ACVP member became dual certified by examination, (September 9-11, 2014).

#### Annual Meeting

The 65th annual meeting in Atlanta, GA, Nov. 8-12, 2014, was a combined meeting with the American Society of Investigative Pathology (ASIP), and the American Society of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ASVCP).

The 66th Annual Meeting in Minneapolis, MN, Oct. 17- 21, 2015 will be a combined meeting with the Society of Toxicologic Pathology (STP) and ASVCP .
