



ACVP 2012-2017 Strategic Plan

- Continued implementation for the 2012 – 2017 Strategic Plan.
- Relevant to the new plan, ACVP implemented the following:
 - **Certifying Examination Board** – the Certifying Examination Board is working with the American Board of Pathology (ABP) to transition the ACVP Phase II certifying examination to the ABP testing center.
 - **Maintenance of Certification Development Committee** – the online portal that members will use to record their education hours is in beta testing by ACVP members.

2015 Achievements

- Provided 17 extern scholarships for veterinary students.
- Implemented a two part examination with 236 candidates taking Phase I on March 19, 2015. 202 candidates received a passing score.
- Certified 61 new veterinary anatomic pathologists, 24 new veterinary clinical pathologists and one ACVP members became dual certified with the Phase II certifying examination on September 8-9, 2015.
- Awarded the Harold W. Casey Scholarship to Dr. Kristina Meichner of the North Carolina State University, College of Veterinary Medicine.
- Pledged \$1,000 for each of 40 ACVP Student Chapter in travel support funds to encourage attendance at the Annual Meeting of the College. Members from 32 Student Chapters attended the 2015 meeting using travel awards.
- Held the 66th annual meeting in Minneapolis, MN, Oct. 17-21, 2013 jointly with the Society of Toxicologic Pathology and the American Society for Clinical Pathology. The 67th Annual Meeting will be in New Orleans, LA, Dec. 3 – 7, 2016.
